

Instructions to View and Accept your 2022-2023 Financial Aid Award Package:

1. Log onto BisonWeb
2. Click on Financial Aid
3. Click on Award
4. Go to Award by aid year 22-23
5. Click the Terms and Conditions tab
6. Scroll down and click “Accept”
7. Then click on the Accept Award Offer tab
8. Accept or decline your Subsidized/Unsubsidized loans
9. Then click the submit button

Complete and Submit the 2022-2023 Howard University Freshman Scholarship (HUFSA) Agreement:

- Log into BisonWeb
- Select the Financial Aid option
- Select Eligibility
- Select Student Requirements
- Sign and submit the Scholarship Agreement document

Incomplete Verification:

If you have been selected for verification, Howard University is working with our third-party partner, Inceptia.

[Verification Gateway for Students - Inceptia](#). Howard is working collaboratively with Inceptia to put together your personal 2022-2023 financial aid award, but we need to collect some additional information from you. Your financial aid application was selected by the United States Department of Education (Department) for verification. Do not worry. Each year, random applications are selected by the Department to have you verify the information you entered on your FAFSA.

To make the process easy for you, Howard partners with Inceptia, a nonprofit organization, who are verification experts.

Here's what you need to do:

- Go to Inceptia's secure site [here](#) to get started.
- In the Find My School box, select **District of Columbia** as the state and **Washington** as the city
 - Click Search
 - Select Howard University
 - Select the 2022-2023 aid year
 - Create an account if you are a first-time user
 - For returning users, please enter your email address and password
- Complete the items on your personalized to-do list (your Task List) and upload requested documentation.
- Once you have completed your to-do list (your Task List), make sure to e-sign your account! We cannot complete the verification process without that signature.

We cannot complete your financial aid until you complete verification - so please do not delay. We look forward to seeing you soon at Howard.

If you have been selected for Verification for multiple aid years, you will need to create an account for each aid year (e.g., 2021-22, 2022-23). The link provided above is for the 2021-22 only. For links to prior aid years please see your email account provided on the FAFSA or visit [Inceptia.org](https://www.inceptia.org) to find all available links.
