2023-2024 TEACH Grant Information Sheet

Each year you receive a Teach Grant award disbursement, you must sign a TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve that is available electronically on the Teach Grant Agreement to Serve website: https://studentloans.gov.

TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve (ATG)

The TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve specifies the following conditions under which the grant will be awarded:

- For each TEACH Grant-eligible program for which you received TEACH Grant funds, you must serve as a full-time teacher
 for a total of at least FOUR academic years within eight calendar years after you completed or withdrew from the academic
 program for which you received the TEACH Grant.
- You must perform the teaching service as a highly-qualified teacher at a low-income school. The term highly-qualified teacher is defined in section 9101(23) of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 or in section 602(10) of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
- Your teaching service must be in high-need field, see below for requirements.
- You must comply with any other requirements that the Department of Education determines to be necessary.
- If you do not complete the required teaching service obligation, TEACH Grant funds you received will be converted to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan that you must repay, with interest charged from the date of the TEACH Grant disbursement.

Note: Teach Grant recipients will be given a 6-month grace period prior to entering repayment if a TEACH Grant is converted to a Direct Unsubsidized Loan.
