**If you or your parents worked in the US, Tax Return Transcripts and Verification of Non-Filing must be requested from the IRS either online at www.irs.gov or by calling (800) 908-9946. For approved tax extensions, you must provide Form 4868 in lieu of the transcripts. If you amended your tax returns, you must also include a signed Form 1040X with the transcript.

*** Guidelines to which parent's details are required, regardless of whether parents are of the same or opposite sex:

- If your parents (your biological and/or adoptive parents, or parents as determined by country [e.g., a parent listed on your birth certificate]) are married to each other, answer the questions about both of them • If your parents are not married to each other but live together, answer the questions about both of them.
- If your parent is widowed or was never married, answer the questions about that parent.
