What is Certification?

Certification is a requirement of state agencies and some additional scholarship organizations prior to sending the funds to colleges and universities.

When do we complete certification?

Certification is completed after add/drop. We complete it after add/drop as we know sometimes your schedule may change and we want to make sure students receive the accurate amount of funding from the scholarship organizations.

DC TAG

- Eligibility determined through the DC Tag agency for DC residents.
- https://dconeapp.dc.gov/.
- Award amount of \$1,250 per semester.

DC CAP

- Eligibility determined by District of Columbia College Access Program.
- Must be a graduate of a DC public or public charter school.
- <u>www.dccap.org</u>.
- Amount varies based on enrollment and DC CAP program.

DC MAYORS

- Eligibility determined through the DC OSSE Agency for DC.
- https://osse.dc.gov/page/dc-mayors-scholars-information-students.
- Amount varies.

Massachusetts State Grant

- Eligibility determined by MASS Grant. Must be a resident of Massachusetts.
- https://www.mass.edu/osfa/programs/massgrantawardterms.asp.
- Up to \$300 per semester.

Ameri Corp

- Eligibility determined based on your participation in Ameri Corp.
- https://my.americorps.gov.
- Award amounts vary per student.

PHEAA

- Eligibility determined through the PHEAA agency for Pennsylvania residents.

- Up to \$300 per semester for 2023-2024.

Maryland Higher Education Commission (MHEC)

- Eligibility determined by state of Maryland.
- Different awards offered (i.e. Need Based, Legislative, Career/Occupation, etc.).

- Amount varies.

Delaware Department of Education Scholarships

- Eligibility determined by Delaware Department of Education.

- Amount varies.

Vermont State Grant

- Eligibility determined by Vermont State Grant. Must be a resident of Vermont.
- www.vsac.org.
- Amount varies.

Gates Millennium Scholarship

- Eligibility determined by Gates. All student can apply.

- Amount Varies.

Benjamin Gilman International Scholarship

- Eligibility determined by Gilman organization.

- For study abroad students.
- Amount varies.

Daniels Fund Scholarship

- Eligibility is determined by the organization. Must be a Colorado, New Mexico, Utah or Wyoming based resident.

- Award amounts vary per student.

What is a HUFS Scholarship?

An Institutional scholarship for incoming freshmen.

How do you qualify for a HUFS scholarship?

- Must be an incoming First Time in College Student (FTIC).
- It is awarded based on an established matrix.
- International students only qualify for merit portion of HUFS.

• There are 7 different types of HUFS scholarships that a student could qualify for based on the matrix.

• Continuing students can apply for donor scholarships. (Incoming freshman and transfer students are not eligible)


How do you apply for a donor scholarship?
