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Federal TEACH Grant Information Sheet and Application

Each year you receive a Teach Grant award disbursement, you must sign a TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve that is available electronically on the Teach Grant Agreement to Serve website: https://studentaid.gov/teach-grant-program.

TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve (ATG)

The TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve specifies the following conditions under which the grant will be awarded:

- For each TEACH Grant-eligible program for which you received TEACH Grant funds, you must serve as a full-time teacher
 for a total of at least FOUR academic years within eight calendar years after you completed or withdrew from the academic
 program for which you received the TEACH Grant.
- You must perform the teaching service as a highly-qualified teacher at a low-income school. The term highly- qualified teacher is defined in section 9101(23) of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 or in section 602(10) of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
- Your teaching service must be in a high-need field, see below for requirements.
- You must comply with any other requirements that the Department of Education determines to be necessary.
- If you do not complete the required teaching service obligation, the TEACH Grant funds you received will be converted to a Federal Direct Unsubsidized Stafford Loan that you must repay, with interest charged from the date of the TEACH Grant disbursement.

Note: Teach Grant recipients will be given a 6-month grace period prior to entering repayment if a TEACH Grant is converted to a Direct Unsubsidized Loan.

High-Need Fields are the specific areas identified below:

- Bilingual Education and English Language Acquisition
- Foreign Language
- Mathematics
- Reading Specialist
- Science
- Special Education
- Other identified teacher shortage areas as of the time you begin teaching in that field. These are teacher subject shortage areas (not geographic areas) that are listed in the "Department of Education's Annual Teacher Shortage Area Nationwide Listing." Schools serving low-income students:
